

# Disability Orientation and Induction

Safe Actions conducts manual tasks training consistent with the Code of Practice: Manual Tasks and based on the needs of workers in the Disability sector. The OSH regulations, risk management and reporting are covered in the theory section.

The Disability Sector Orientation and Induction Manual Tasks short course covers:

- Supporting in sitting, standing and walking an individual
- Moving an individual forwards and backwards in a chair
- Rolling an individual in bed
- Using a slide sheet to turn an individual in bed and move them up the bed
- Assisting an individual from lying to sitting on the side of the bed and reverse
- Guiding an individual up from the floor
- Hoisting from bed to chair
- Inserting a sling when the individual is seated
- Transferring a wheelchair into a vehicle
- Use of standing hoist and other manual tasks assistive equipment

In this 7.5 hour course, workers are coached in self protective behaviours when completing these tasks and the use of equipment to reduce the risk or effort associated with these activities.

This course is ideal for workers who are new to the industry and those requiring a refresher of their manual tasks training. Attendance certificates and manuals are available on request.

Content can be customised to suit a particular organisation.
