Safe Actions conducts manual tasks training consistent with the Code of Practice: Manual Tasks and based on the needs of workers in the Disability sector. The WHS Act and relevant regulations, risk management and reporting are covered in the theory section.

The Disability Sector Orientation and Induction Manual Tasks short course covers:

- Supporting in sitting, standing and walking a student
- Moving a student forwards and backwards in a chair
- Guiding a student up from the floor
- Use of standing hoist and other manual tasks assistive equipment

In this 3.5 hour course, workers are coached in self protective behaviours when completing these tasks and the use of equipment to reduce the risk or effort associated with these activities.

This course is ideal for workers who are new to the industry and those requiring a refresher of their manual tasks training. Attendance certificates and manuals are available on request.
