

Safe Transporting in Cars, Buses and Vans

Safe Actions conducts manual tasks training consistent with the Code of Practice: Manual Tasks and based on the needs of workers in the Aged Care and Disability environment. The WHS regulations, risk management, reporting and interaction with other legislative and Australian standard requirements are covered in the theory section.

The Manual Tasks - Cars, Buses & Vans short course covers assisting a person with:

- Sitting and standing from a car / bus seat
- Repositioning in chairs
- Walking
- Up and down bus steps
- Placing wheelchair or walker in vehicle
- Applying a wheelchair and occupant restraint systems in a van
- Range of assistive equipment



In this 6.5 hour course, workers are coached in self protective behaviours when completing these tasks and the use of equipment to reduce the risk or effort associated with these activities.

This course is ideal for workers who are new to the community care and disability sectors and those requiring a refresher of their manual tasks training.
